Attendance and Punctuality

Regular attendance and punctuality are very important and we will work with parents to instill good habits.

For children to gain maximum benefit from school it is essential not only that they attend every day, but that they are in good time to listen to the instructions for the day.

Getting your child to school on time really matters.

Did you know...

If in a school year your child is late everyday...	your child would have lost approximately...	or they would have missed approximately...
5 minutes	3.5 days from school	20 lessons
10 minutes	7 days from school	41 lessons
15 minutes	10 days from school	55 lessons
20 minutes	14.5 days from school	82 lessons
30 minutes	22 days from school	123 lessons

You should not take your child on holiday during term time.
Please encourage punctuality to maintain school attendance.
Remember Absence = Lost Opportunity

Uniform

PE Kit

Jewellery

-French

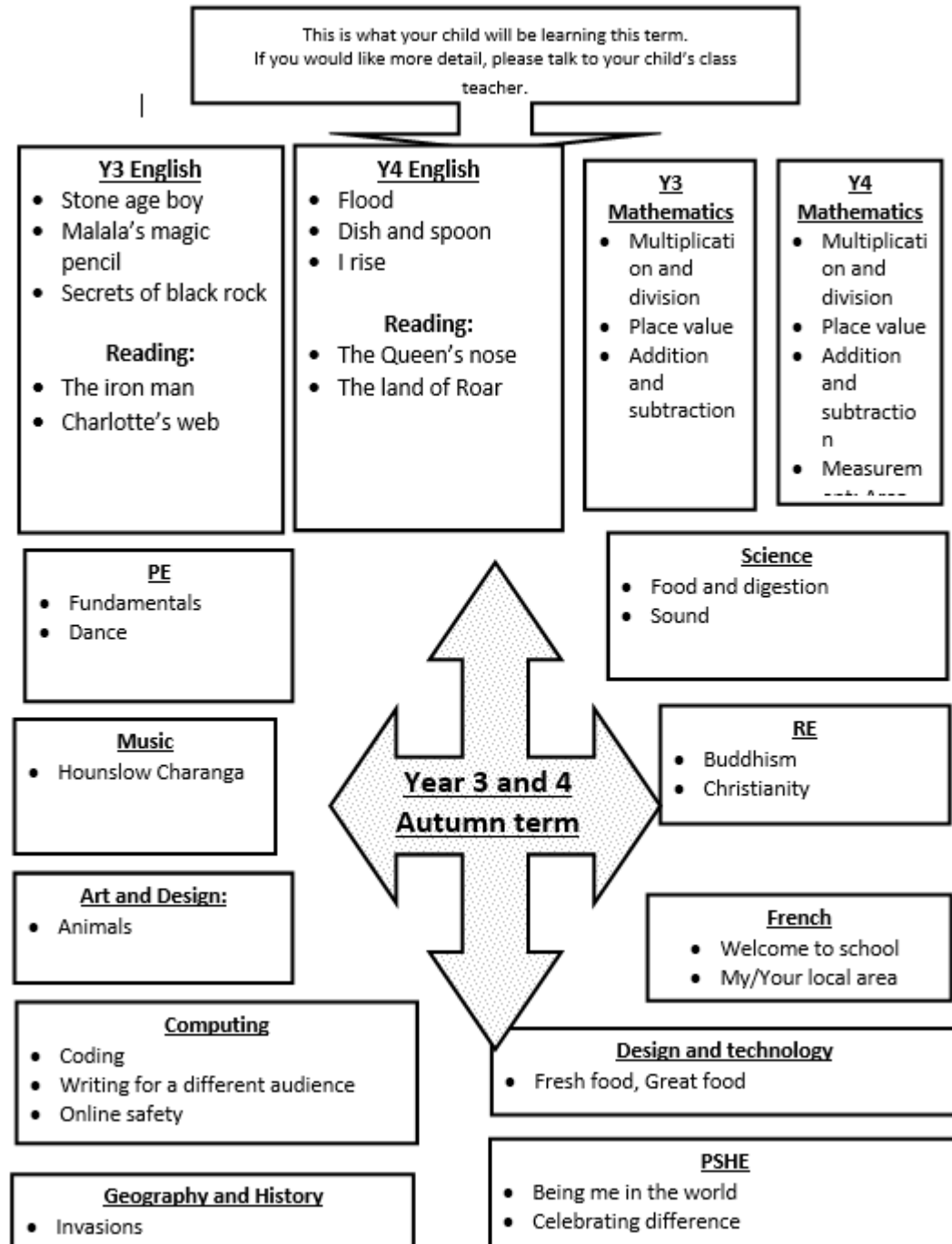

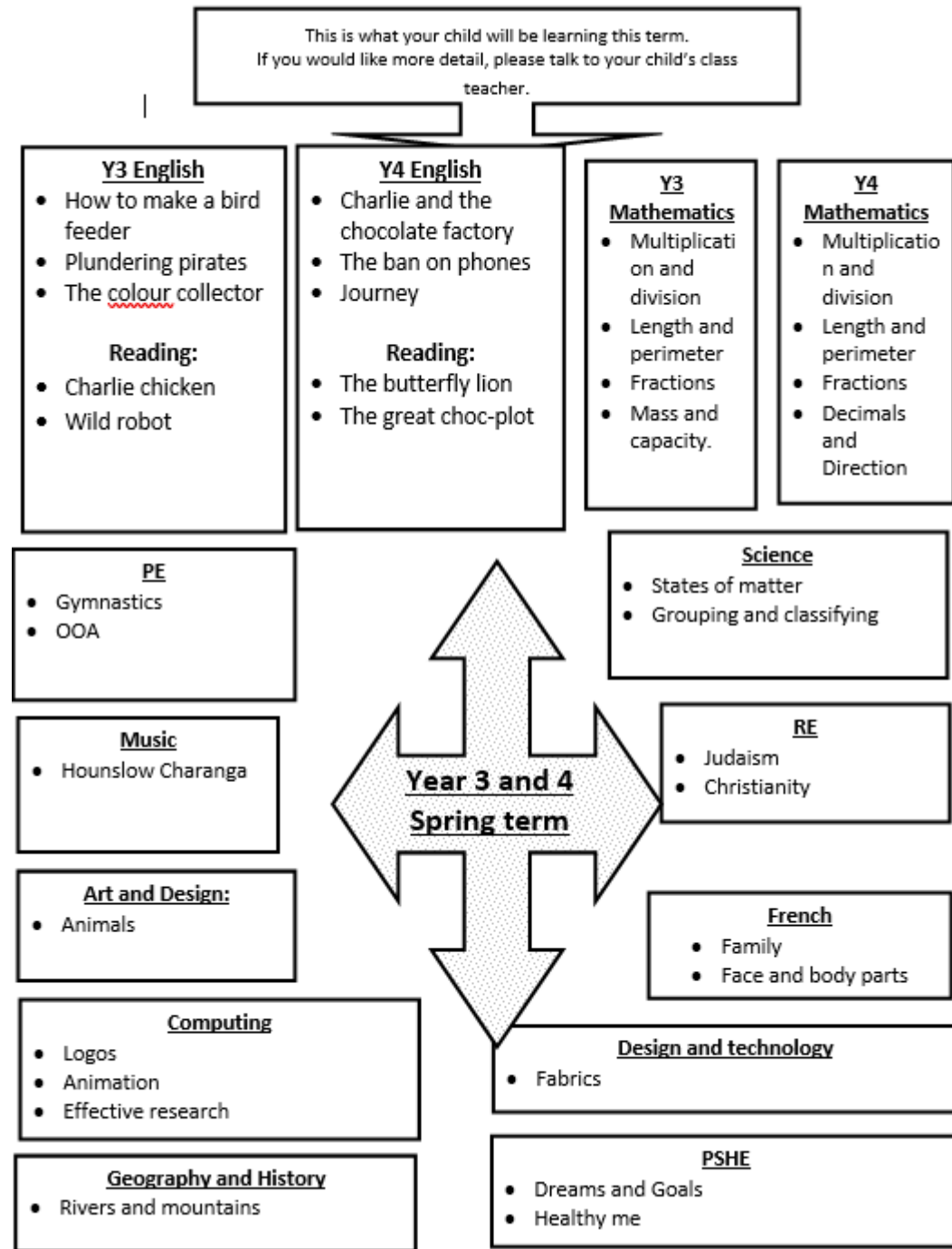
Intervention groups happen throughout the day, including during registration.



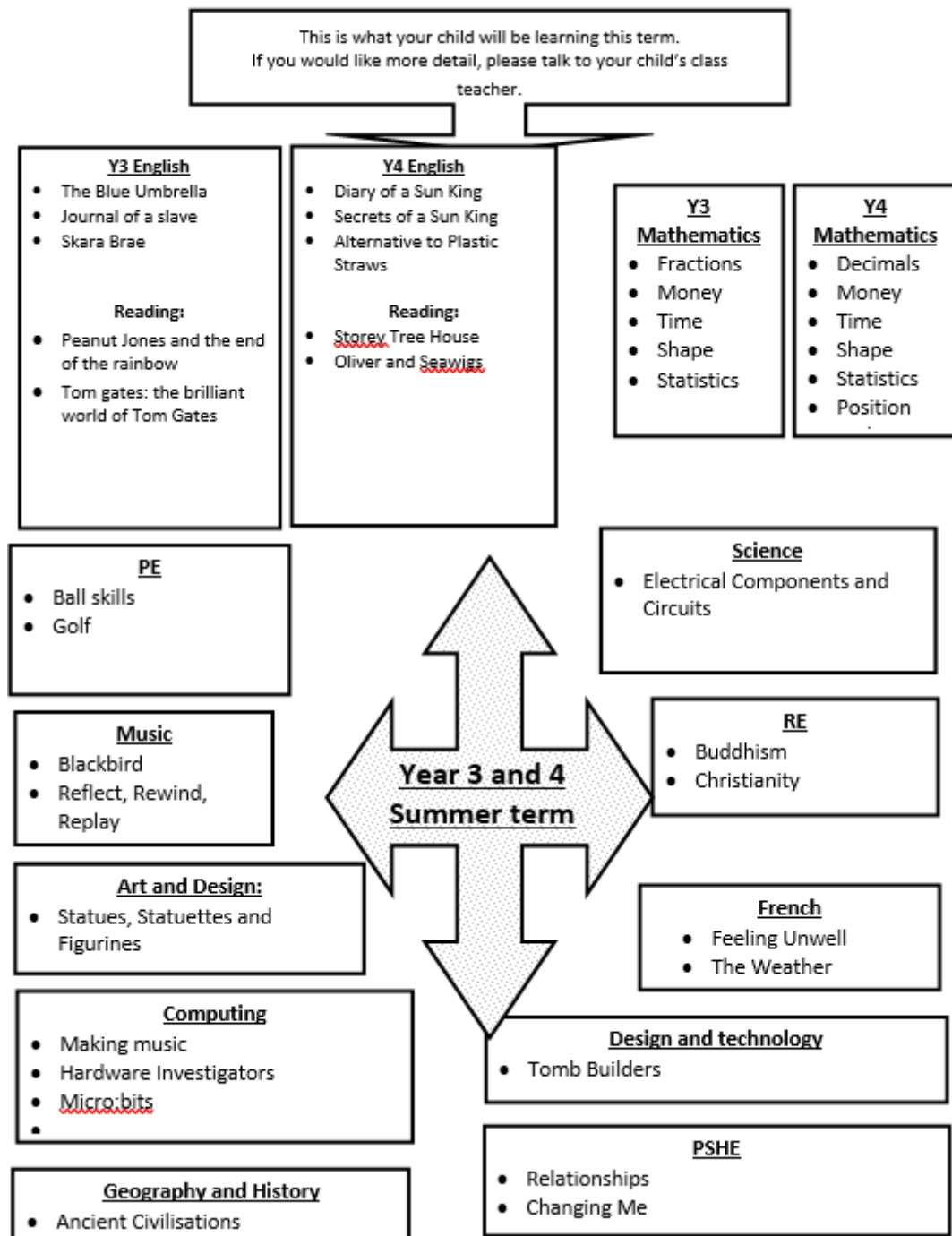
Autumn Curriculum Overview

Homework and Reading



- In Year 3 and 4, we expect each child to read at home at least 5 different days each week.
- Mathematics and English Homework is set on a Wednesday and due in on a Monday.
- Spellings are set on a Monday for the week and are tested on a Friday.
