

Activities at home

PSE - keeping safe at home

Talk to children about how they are kept safe at home and the reasons why. E.g. dangers of boiling water/hot drinks, cookers etc.

In books ask children to draw things they are not allowed to touch and use their Fred sounds to label their own pictures.

Talk about the importance of healthy eating choices for breakfast, lunch and tea/dinner. Encourage children to think about why we eat a range of foods to keep healthy.

In books, draw an example of their choice of a healthy breakfast, lunch, tea/dinner.

Traditional tales

UW - growth and change

Look at photos of the children from birth to present day to discuss how the children have changed and how they may still be the same. Please upload onto tapestry/stick photos into book so that we can discuss them at school.

Numeracy - What size are your feet? UW - range of materials for different purposes

Visit a shoe shop to get feet measured. Look at a range of different shoes, talk about similarities, differences, sizes and foot wear for different purposes including range of different materials. In books, draw pictures of different shoe types seen and discussed using phonics cues to write dominant sounds to label. E.g. 'bts' might be all the children hear and can write for 'boots' as children may not be able to write the sound "oo"
