- To monitor provision and consider curricular issues which have implications for finance and personnel decisions and to make recommendations to the relevant committees or the Governing Body
- To keep abreast of developments in the curriculum
- Subject Leaders to inform governors of developments in their areas
- To contribute towards the development of the School Development Plan
- To regularly monitor and review the development of the School Development Plan and its impact
- To know the school's judgements in relation to Ofsted judgements and continue to aspire to the "outstanding " judgement
- To understand the school's performance and pupil progress data
- To hold the school to account for its' performance by regularly reviewing the Governor's monitoring overview
- To be aware of vulnerable groups
- To consider and seek ways to make the performance of the school outstanding in all respects
- To monitor that all groups of learners make at least good progress or better
- To act as a link between the community and the governing body on all matters relating to curriculum.
- Prior agreement for visitors to attend the meeting and establish their role as to whether they are an observer or an active participant
- To maintain confidentiality
- Members should not be involved in discussions where there is a conflict of interest.
