

## **Interventions at Cardinal Road School may include:**

### Fischer Family Trust - Wave 3 Intervention

This programme is delivered by experienced teaching assistants working one to one with a Year 1 or Year 2 pupil for 15-20 minutes per day for 10-20 weeks. It is for those pupils working at a lower than expected level of literacy and is tailored to the needs of the individual pupil. Reading and writing are taught on alternate days.

### Language for Thinking- Wave 3 Intervention

Children who have been identified as having specific difficulties with understanding language receive support to work on improving their listening and comprehension skills. The children work 1:1 with a Teacher Assistant for 15 mins per week.

### Phonics - Wave 2 Intervention

A teaching assistant supports children who have been identified in Year 2 and/or Year 1 as requiring support to develop their phonological knowledge to further their reading and spelling skills. This intervention is delivered in a small group or on a one to one basis depending on the needs of the child. A structured programme is followed.

### Fine Motor Skills - Wave 2 Intervention

For some children, developing pencil and scissor control requires extra practise. This is provided in school by teaching assistants in Reception and KS1. Advice is sought from outside agencies as necessary.

### Maths Support - Wave 2 Intervention

This is a structured one to one intervention for those children who struggle with numeracy. Again it is an individualised programme, delivered to Year 2 pupils twice a week for 15 minutes. It is delivered by a trained teaching assistant.
