

School street and red route email sent to parents 24th April 2023.

Dear Parents,

In October last year we emailed you a copy of the proposal to make the area around Cardinal Road School into a School Street and red route and a link to comment on the proposal.

We have today received confirmation that the consultation has been passed by Hounslow Council and will go live on **Monday 22 May 2023.**

school street

Access restrictions will operate Monday to Friday 8:15am to 9:15am and again 2:45pm to 3:45pm during school term time.

During these times, only pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles registered by residents or school staff are permitted to enter Cardinal Road. There is no impact on traffic leaving the road during the hours of operation - vehicles can therefore leave the road at any time.

The restrictions will be enforced by the Council through the use of CCTV, which could be either mobile or fixed cameras.

red route

(no stopping at any time) restrictions will be at the junction of Cardinal Road and Hanworth Road, between its junction with Hounslow Road and No 6 Hanworth Road. Any vehicle stopping on them risks being issued with a penalty notice charge (PCN).

Work to erect the traffic signs at the boundary of the zone and to mark the red route restrictions are due to start today - Monday 24th April, and the scheme will go live on Monday 22nd May.
