

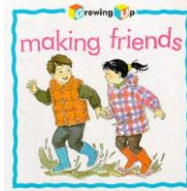
## Autumn 1 KS1 Language Group

They will learn the routines and 'rules of good listening'.

Tense focus: Simple continuous present tense

The children will be learning to answer the question 'What are they doing?' using spoken and written language using the 'subject, verb, object, location' structure. The pupils will learn how colourful semantics will support their understanding and sentence structure. They will learn when to use is and when to use are. They will learn to use the pronouns I, he, she, they accurately. They will include appropriate adjectives in their sentences to add detail and interest. They will extend their sentences to include when, how and why.

## Making Friends



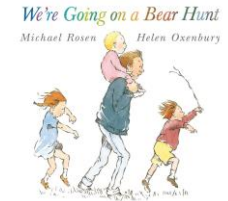
Example target sentence:

They are eating a picnic in the forest.

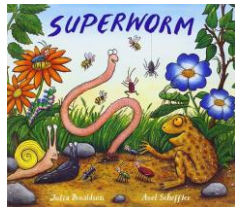
## We're Going on a Bear Hunt

They are walking in the long grass because they want to find a bear.

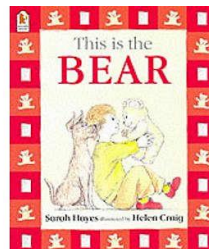

## Superworm



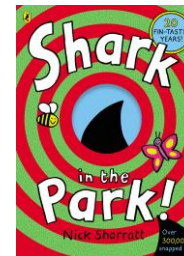
Example target sentence:

## This is the Bear



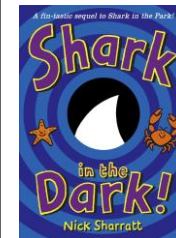
Example target sentence:
