

## Autumn 1 Reception Language

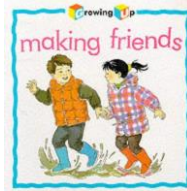

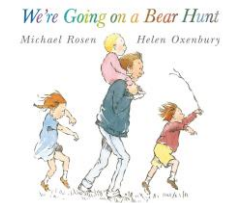
Example target sentence:

They are eating a picnic in the forest.

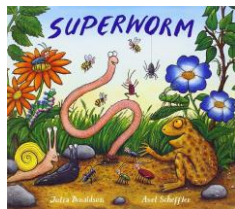

They are walking in the grass.

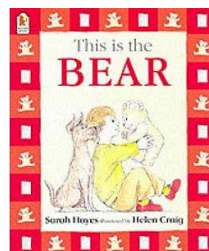

## Superworm



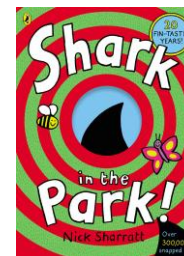
Example target sentence:

## This is the Bear



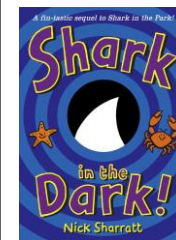
Example target sentence:
