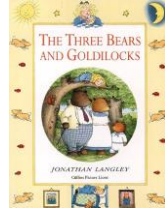


Spring 1 Reception Language Group

The Three Bears and Goldilocks



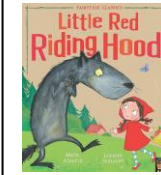
Example target sentence:

Example target sentence: Jack knocked on the door at the top of the beanstalk.

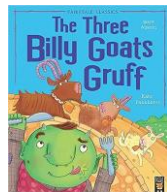
Little Red Riding Hood
