They will learn the routines and 'rules of good listening'.

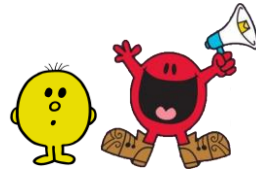
Speech focus: Hearing the difference between loud and quiet speech sounds. Loud sounds are those which use your voice and quiet sounds are those that don't (we don't mean shouting and whispering).

Each week (following a week on things that are quiet and things that are loud) the pair of sounds are made in the same way in the mouth except one uses your voice and one doesn't.

Activities routinely covered:

- sound sorting
- point to the object I say
- oral blending
- minimal pairs sorting
- bingo
- syllable clapping
- saying consonants with a vowel
- letter writing
- quick flashcards
- sorting quiet and loud sounds
- singing linked to the week's sounds
- discussions about the lip and tongue positions
- learning cues
- learning / saying vocabulary linked to the sounds
- right / wrong judgement game

The Tiger Who Came to Tea



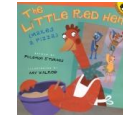
Story:

This week the children will sort words beginning with the quiet sound t from those beginning with the loud sound d.

p vs b

Story: The Little Red Hen Makes a Pizza



Vocabulary: pizza people pirate penguins pineapple puree pitta bread peppers pig big ball boot bell bottle bee

This week the children will sort words beginning with the quiet sound p from those beginning with the loud sound b.

Story: There's A Snake In My School

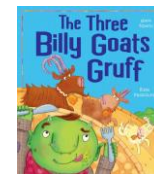


Vocabulary: Snake Sausages Sand Spiders See Sand Sock

This week the children will sort words beginning with the quiet sound s from those beginning with the loud sound z.

c vs g

Story: The Three Billy Goats



Vocabulary: Goat green grass glasses girl gate cat cake cat caterpillar cow coat

This week the children will sort words beginning with the quiet sound c from those beginning with the loud sound g.

f vs v

Story: Jack and the Beanstalk



Vocabulary: Fee fi fo fum fan flower fly fish van vase violin vulture

This week the children will sort words beginning with the quiet sound f from those beginning with the loud sound v.
