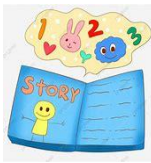


Launch: Getting to know our new friends in Nursery



Understanding the World:

- Celebrate Eid Al Ada.
- Celebrate Diwali.
- Celebrate Black History Week.
- Celebrate Bonfire night.
- Talk about what makes people special to me and others. E.g. families
- Explore and use a range of technology.



Communication and Language

- Learn rules of good looking, good listening (Introduction of 1,2,3 look at me).
- Listen and join in with stories and nursery rhymes.
- Explore and introduce vocabulary through stories, nursery rhymes.

Expressive Arts:

- Explore and experiment with paints, pencils, felt tips, brushes.
- Explore junk modelling.
- Make simple constructions.
- Link with Feltham station and construction of buildings.

Literacy

- Learn nursery rhymes (twinkle twinkle little star, baa baa black sheep, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5...)
- Become familiar with their name card and their peg.
- Explore the book area.
- Look at books.



My Nursery and Me Autumn 1

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Get to know my teachers, my friends and my Nursery.
- Explore each area in the nursery.
- Explore each area's resources independently.
- Separate from carer and settle in the new environment.
- Engage with the environment independently
- Learn the importance of washing hands.

Physical Development:

- Explore the outdoor area and its resources.
- Develop independence putting on and taking off coats and hats.
- Develop independence using the toilet.
- Explore and use mark making implements.



Maths:

- Learn nursery rhymes to support counting skills and numerals knowledge.
- Play and explore 2D shapes,
- Explore maths resources across the areas in the room.
- Identify and sort objects according to colours.
- Create repeating patterns.
- Explore subitising.
