Yr2 Performances

Yr2 are performing two end of year concerts which parents and carers can attend.

One of these performances is for adults and younger children if alternative arrangements cannot be made for the siblings. It is at least 30 min so a long time to sit for the younger children. There is not room for buggies/prams to be taken into the hall but they can be left in the walkway.

The second performance is for adults only.

Each family will be issued with two tickets. The tickets will be numbered and will be printed in the colour of your child's class. We will check these on your arrival.

Two adults from a family can attend **one** performance or one adult can attend the **two** performances. We will not accept tickets that have been issued to another family.

You will be able to wait in the playground on the morning of the performances until the children have entered their classrooms and we will then be ready to check the tickets.
