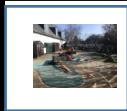
Reading Mornings

- **Pathways of support** - finding and using your voice; identifying services that answer your needs rather than being told what you need; discarding old patterns for positive relationships

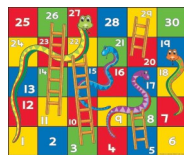
