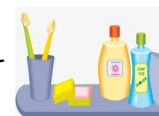
Maths Meeting

The governors meet regularly to ensure that they understand how the school operates and that the children are enjoying their learning. They would like to thank you for helping your children with their homework.



Christmas Productions

We will be performing some Christmas productions for you to watch.

We ask that only **two** adults from each family attends **one** performance. Two adults can attend the same performance or one adult could attend two performances. We do not have the capacity for any more adults to attend.

There are two performances planned for each Year Group. One of these is for adults and younger children, if alternative arrangements cannot be made. If you can possibly organise for the younger children not to attend it would be appreciated. There is not room for buggies/prams to be taken into the hall. It is a health and safety requirement. We cannot have younger children running around as it is a hazard and disruptive. Performances will be about half an hour so may be too long for some of the younger siblings. The second performance is for adults only.

Each family will be issued with two tickets to attend the performances. The tickets will be numbered and will be printed in the colour of your child's class. We will check these on your arrival.

The playground gate on Cardinal Road will be opened at **9:15am** for Reception and Yr1 performances to enable you to access the hall through the playground and walkway. The gate will be shut at **9:25am**. This gives us 5 min to get the children to the hall. Unfortunately, we will not be able to admit anybody into the performance after 9:25am or through the front Reception area. We expect the performances to end at approximately 10am.

The playground gate on Cardinal Road will remain open until 9:10am for Yr2 performances to enable you to access the hall through the playground and walkway. We will start admitting parents at 9:00am and you will be able to wait in the playground in class queues until this time. Unfortunately, we will not be able to admit anybody into the performance after 9:10am or through the front Reception area. We expect the performances to end at approximately 9:45am.



Congestion

Please be mindful of others around you when queuing to come through the gates into the playground. Be patient so pushing does not occur. It is a relatively small space for you all to pass through.
